Applications should include the following:

A copy of the applicant's college/high school transcript.

A list of all extracurricular activities, community activities, jobs and internships participated in while in college/high school, including years and noteworthy positions held.

A written statement, no more than 1,000 words in length, explaining the applicant's reason for deciding to pursue an education in law or a legally related field

While not required, applicants may choose to send:

Up to two letters of recommendation.

Any other information that the selection committee should take into consideration when reviewing the application.
